- 4. No recording of speeches or picture taking during the contest unless previously agreed upon by all contestants and contest chair.
- 5. Instruct audience to turn off or silence their cell phones. (If Sgt. at Arms did not)
- 6. Evaluation Contest followed by International Contest.
